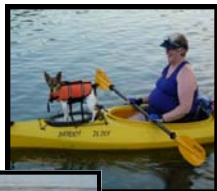

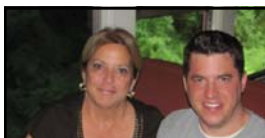
OCTOBER 22, 2011
